

LESSON

BOTTOM LINE: There is no one like God.

OBJECTIVE: In this lesson little ones will learn no matter how great we think we are, no one is as big and great as God.

KEY PASSAGE: Genesis 11:1-9, The Tower of Babel

WORSHIP TIME:

Prior to the lesson, sing one or two songs with the kids. Use CDs or live lyrics of songs that the kids are familiar with.

LESSON:

Today's story comes to us from the Bible. (Hold up a Bible.) The Bible is God's Word to us, so we know that everything it says is true. (Open the Bible and set it down in front of you as you give the lesson.)

There is no one like God. God is big and great. He made the world and all the people in it.

At one time all of the people were in one place and spoke one language. One day the people decided they were big and great too. As big and as great as God.

The people decided to build a tower so high that it would reach all the way up to God in Heaven. So they built and built and built.

God needed to show them that there is no one as big and as great as him. So instead of one language, he made it so the people spoke many languages. And instead of living in one place, God scattered the people to live throughout the world.

The people stopped building the tower. They saw now that God is big and great. There is no one like God.

(Possible storytelling tool: Tell the story with Legos or other building blocks. Use Lego men to represent the people. Have the tower pre-built into sections. Add a new section onto the tower each time you say "built.")

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THERE IS NO ONE LIKE GOD

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:

PRIVING:

Talk about some of the impressive things that humans have made: your home, roads, and your car. Now compare it to the things that God has made: the sun, the earth, plants, animals and people. There is no one as big and great as God.

PLAYING:

Get out the building blocks and build the highest tower you can. How many building blocks would you need to reach up to Heaven? How long would that take? Do we need to build a tower to be near our great God?

EATING:

During your mealtime prayer, thank God for being so big and great. Be thankful that there is no one like God.

Hold your little ones close and remind them of how big and great God is. Assure them that God is also loving. He is as close to them as your hug. There is no one like God.
