LESSON POINTS

Bible Story | David Defeats Philistine Giants

2 Samuel 21:15-22:4

- David and his men were at war with the Philistine giants.
- David got very tired.
- A giant was about to kill David.
- One of David's men, Abishai, came and killed the giant, saving David.
- David and his men killed four giants.
- When the battle was over David sang a song to God.
- God was David's Strength and defeated his enemies.

MINISTRY IDEA

Warrior Dance

Express praise and joy to the Lord by freely dancing to a high energy praise song. Tell children to be serious about their active worship making sure they are glorifying the Lord.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do you think David thought when he was getting tired?
2. How did God use Abishai?
3. Where did Abishai's strength come from?
4. Why did David praise God at the end of the battle?
5. Tell about a time when you relied on God's strength to save you.

ACTIVITY IDEAS

Swords

Have the kids make swords out of poster board or cardboard. They can decorate it with anything they like. Suggest they write the memory verse on it as well.

A Song of Thanks

Have the kids write a song to God to the tune of a familiar song. Have them write things they are thankful God has done in their life.

LESSON OBJECTIVE

Children will learn that God is our Strength, and he defeats our enemies.

LIFE APPLICATION

Through learning that God is our Strength, kids will know that the strength they receive to defeat their enemies will come from God.
