LESSON POINTS

Bible Story: Jesus Is Alive –
John 20 & 21; Luke 24:13-35

- Jesus was alive! No one had stolen Him.
- Jesus appeared to Mary and told her to go tell the others she saw Him.
- Jesus took a walk with 2 other disciples.
- Jesus showed Thomas the scars in His hands.
- Jesus fixed breakfast on the beach and ate with the disciples.
- Jesus gave proof that He was alive!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where was Jesus when the disciples went to the place He was buried?
2. What did Jesus tell Mary to do?
3. Tell about some of the people that saw Jesus alive.
4. How do you know that Jesus is alive today?

MINISTRY IDEA

Have a time of praise and worship encouraging children and leaders to be exuberant and expressive with their joy for what the Lord has done for them.

ACTIVITY IDEAS

Party Time

Bring or make party hats and other party items and talk about why we love Jesus so much.

Tell About It

Talk to children about how important it is to tell everyone about Jesus. Have a stuffed animal, doll, or other toy (if there are enough toys let each child hold one) that children can practice telling about Jesus. Leader should demonstrate telling about Jesus and then let children tell their toy about Jesus.

OBJECTIVE

Children will learn how Jesus was a giver. He gave so that we could have many things – healing, forgiveness, life, an example, and victory over death.

APPLICATION

Through learning how Jesus gave and produced life, children see that when they give God makes great things happen.
