

LESSON SNAPSHOT

BOTTOM LINE:

When we are in pain, God is there.

OBJECTIVE:

Kids will learn that God can comfort them no matter how painful life is.

KEY PASSAGE:

Mark 4:35-41. Jesus Calms the Storm

MEMORY VERSE:

"When I am afraid, I put my trust in you." - Psalm 56:3 (NIV)

Have the kids practice saying their memory verse, then see who can say it backwards

SUMMARY:

Nobody wants to experience pain, suffering, or death. It's scary to think about. But when you remember that Jesus is with you, you can handle any of life's painful difficul-ties.

SIMPLE PRAYER:

Dear God.

Be near us when we are in pain, and give us comfort. Let us know that you are always near us.

In Jesus' name, Amen



EASY AT HOME OBJECT LESSON

ITEMS NEEDED:

Neosporin, Band Aids, other first aid supplies

Set the first aid supplies in front of the kids.

If you were to get hurt and get a bad scrape on your knee, which of these things would you use to help clean and treat your cut?

Let the kids answer and walk you through a typical first aid routine, all the way through the kiss to make it better.

Let me ask you this. Which of these things, if any, will take away your pain?

None of them will, will they? Cleaning the wound might make it a little more sore. So will the Neosporin. And covering it with the Band Aid will keep it clean, but it'll still hurt for a bit. Even Mom's magic kiss can't always take away the pain.

But even though Mom can't take the pain away, it helps to know she cares, doesn't it? Knowing Mom loves you and feels your pain helps you get through the hurt faster.

Life can be pretty painful, and sometimes the pain doesn't go away very quickly. But no matter how bad our pain may be, God cares and will be with us. He will be by our side, and he will comfort us.

Sometimes God takes away the bad things in our lives. Sometimes the bad thing remains, but God is there with us, helping us get through it. Whatever tough situation you are facing, tell Jesus about it, and he will be there.
