Jonah: Message Delivered

LESSON POINTS

**Bible Story: Goes to Nineveh
Jonah 3**

- Jonah went to Nineveh like God told him.
- Jonah told them God's message.
- The people believed God and said they were sorry.
- The people of Nineveh started doing right and were saved.
- Because Jonah humbled himself and delivered God's message to Nineveh, the people were saved.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When Jonah said ok to God's way, how did he obey God?
2. How did the people of Nineveh feel after listening to Jonah?
3. How did the people change in Nineveh after Jonah spoke to them?
4. What happened because of Jonah being humble (doing things God's way)?
5. How do you feel when you have helped someone?

MINISTRY IDEA

Ask some leaders to pray before and during service for prophetic words in season to give to encourage the children.

ACTIVITY IDEAS

Memory Verse Reminders

Help the children learn the memory verse by breaking it down for them. Add hand motions or actions for different words to help them remember. You can even practice saying it in funny voices with the children to make it more fun.

Hide and Seek

Bring a book ("Where's Waldo?") or page for the children to look at that has a hidden person or objects to find. Let children take turns finding the person or objects. As they are searching for the person or objects, talk to them about how Jonah tried to hide from God in the same way, but could never do it. God always knows where we are and what we are doing..

OBJECTIVE

Children will learn how Jonah was humble. He admitted that he had made mistakes and went and did what was right.

APPLICATION

Through learning how Jonah humbled himself and thought of others, children see how to obey God, even when its something they might not want to do.
