THIS WEEK'S LESSON: GOD WATCHES OVER ME

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:



DRIVING:

Show your kids the rearview and side mirrors of your car. Explain that they are there so you can see not only the backseat, but also the other cars on the road behind you. It's how you are able to drive safe. Talk about how God watches over and protects us.



PLAYING:

Get out the building blocks and build Noah's ark, complete with animals. Retell the story of Noah with your little ones.



EATING:

During your mealtime prayer thank God for watching over you and your family.



SNUGGLING:

Hold your little ones close and let them know how much you enjoy these special times with them. Let them know you are there to protect them and keep them safe. Remind them that even when you can't be with them, God is there watching over them.
