


Salvations and Baptisms: Across all

We also supported the following local ministries in a variety of ways including financial, usage of our facilities, encouragement, and prayer: New Beginnings of Hope Pregnancy Center, Young Life of Lampasas, Alcoholics Anonymous, Hill Country Children's Advocacy, and Wings of Eagles Ministries.

NCC continues to distribute 10 Steps Toward Christ Books for free to assist in discipleship. These are available every week in our foyer.


United States:

Nursery and SPARK Ministries

SPARKLERS is our nursery ministry that provides care and Biblical teaching to our Birth – 4 year-olds on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evening.

Sparklers currently has **13** adult helpers and **8** youth helpers with an average attendance of **12** children.

This year the **SPARKLER** team touched **60** unique children with Christ's love! Our Nursery's New Mom Ministry also presented a new mom with a gift box to help welcome their family's new addition.

SPARK While our SPARK year was cut short due to COVID-19, we were still able to have a great year. 14 volunteers faithfully served 80-90 children each Wednesday evening.

Children began the evening playing games in the sanctuary. We worshipped together and

SHINE! Is our Sunday morning children's ministry that offers a fun experience for school age children. We ministered to **203** different children throughout the year with an average of **30-35** children each week. We continue to have a puppet show for the younger kids and a skit for the older ones. Youth Ministry:

In 2020, our Youth Ministry reached an average of **30** students a week and has touched **95** unique youth through Sunday services and monthly activities.

We have an amazing group of ${\bf 6}$ regular volunteers.

Several of our students participate in the youth worship team, Sunday morning services, and

3 of our youth accepted Christ this year and were baptized. NCC youth meets regularly on Sunday evenings and also monthly for special events.

Worship Ministry:

The Worship Ministry at NCC is constantly growing and increasing our territories! In

this 19-20 year we were able to add the WORSHIP portion of our Sunday morning services to our live stream on YouTube and Facebook. During a time when we were unable to attend church in person, we were still able to worship in our homes as one NCC body! This has been an integral part of connecting with our church family through the ever-changing climate of COVID-19. Other areas of growth

Additional Ministries and Activities:

THIS Marriage ministry: NCC believes strong communities start with strong families, and helping married couples navigate the modern world with a Biblical perspective produces strong marriages. The group meets once a month on the second Wednesday and helps to arrange church wide date night activities for married couples of all ages.

Last year we had 3 church wide events. A luncheon social at Fiesta Winery, a photo scavenger hunt, and a VERY successful "goodwill date night".
